Highwire Press, which comes out of Stanford University, contains over 15 million articles from over 4,500 journals, including 841,262 free full text articles. You will notice that Highwire contains many articles on the human papillomavirus (HPV) but not all are free. Free articles have the indication. "This Article Is FREE".

PubMed

PubMed, a service of the National Library of Medicine, includes over 15 million citations for biomedical articles back to the 1950's. These citations are from MEDLINE and additional life science journals. PubMed includes links to many sites providing full text articles and other related resources. You will notice that PubMed contains many articles on the human papillomavirus but not all are free. Free articles have a colored slash on the article icon.

PubMed Central (PMC) is the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH) free digital archive of biomedical and life sciences journal literature. PMC is an electronic archive of full-text journal articles, offering free access to its contents. PMC contains over half a million articles, most of which have a corresponding entry in PubMed.
