Your search for information on Stephen (Townley) Crane can include books, periodical articles, online databases, and authoritative Internet resources.

Books

Use the **Library Catalog** located on the Cerritos College **Library Home Page** to find books on your topic that are available in the Cerritos College Library.

To find books written **about** Stephen Crane, search by **Subject**. To find books written **by** Stephen Crane, search by **Author**. Always type the last name first, e.g. **Crane, Stephen**.

Some additional *Subject Headings* are:

Authors, American 19th century
Crane, Stephen, 1871-1900, criticism and interpretation

Journal Articles

Journal and magazines usually provide the most current information on a topic. Journal articles are more scholarly or professional while magazine articles tend to be shorter and more general. Newspaper articles, while not usually scholarly or professional, can give you the most current news and some additional facts on your topic.

To find articles on your topic, use one of the online databases listed below. These databases usually provide full-text articles on almost every topic. They are available via the Library Home Page by clicking on **Magazines, Journals, Newspapers & More**. Conduct your search in these databases by using subjects and keywords similar to those you used to locate books.

For remote access to the library databases, login to the **Library** using your Cerritos College ID number.

For historical research, the Library also has print indexes that must be used to find older articles, generally anything published before 1985.
