LOCATING NEWSPAPER EDITORIALS

Your search for **newspaper editorials** can be approached in a variety of ways.

ProQuest Newspapers

- **ProQuest Newspapers** provides access to the *Christian Science Monitor*, *Los Angeles Times*, *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal* and the *Washington Post*.
- You can choose to search an individual newspaper or search the *ProQuest Newspapers Core* database which includes all the above newspapers.
- Select the database(s) you would like to search, then click the title or **Continue**.
- In the **Basic Search** box, type your subject (eg. Health care reform). Limit results to **full text**. Under **More Search Options** choose **Editorial** from the **Document type** pull down.
- Click on **Search**.
- The results are sorted by **Most recent first** unless you change the sort to **Most relevant first**.

NewBank InfoWeb

- **NewsBank** provides access to more than 500 U.S. regional and national newspapers, wire services, and broadcasts.
- Select *Major Metro Titles* to have access to 33 national newspapers.
- You can choose to search an individual newspaper such as the *LA Times*, *Orange County Register*, *USA Today*, *Washington Post*, *Christian Science Monitor* by checking the title box.
- On the first line, type your subject (eg. Health care reform) in the **Search** box and select **All Text** from the pull down menu.
- On the second line choose **and** and **Section** from the two pull down menus. Type the word "**editorials**" in the search box.
- Click on **Search**.

- Request a copy of the print edition of the *LA Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, and *The Long Beach Press Telegram* at the Periodicals Desk. Older issues of these newspapers are available on microfilm.
