Transfer Agreements with Colleges and Universities

Azusa Pacific University Honors Program

1. Azusa Pacific University invites the student in HTCC Honors Programs to consider transferring to the Azusa Pacific Honors Program for the junior and senior year. This will permit HTCC students to graduate with the B.A. degree as a distinguished Honors Scholar.
2. HTCC students will make application for admission the University as a transfer student. Academic scholarships are granted in the general admission process, and not by the Honors program.
3. Every HTCC student who matriculates at APU is encouraged to study abroad, and the value of an international experience is especially stressed to student in the Honors Program. APU has agreements to send 20 junior and 20 senior students to Oxford University each semester, to send eight to the International University in Vienna, to send a similar number to the European American International Center in Pontlevoy, France, and the list includes additional study opportunities in Australia, China, Lithuania, the Middle East, Russia, and others. APU permits the student's Federal and state aid to travel with them, and in may programs the student's APU academic scholarship may also apply.

2. Guaranteed semi-finalist for the \$22,000 Silicon Valley Engineering Scholarship for incoming transfer students for the fall semester only. (Students must fill out an on-line application)
3. Priority consideration for a slot with the Global Technology Initiative (all expense paid two week trip to China) after completion of one academic year of study at SJSU.
4. Guaranteed housing with the Community for Engineering Living and Learning (CELL) in SJSU's Campus Village.
5. Invitation to campus cultural events and a campus tour

UC Berkeley

Transfer Alliance Project (TAP)

1. Cerritos College is a member of UC Berkeley's Transfer Alliance Project (TAP). Scholars' Honors Program students are encouraged to participate in this program at Cerritos College. Students who are interested in this program should contact the Transfer Center. **NOTE: You do not have to be a member of the SHP to join Berkeley's Transfer Alliance Project.**
2. UC Berkeley's Transfer Alliance Project requires at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA (transfer-level courses). **NOTE: The GPA range of transfer students who were admitted to UC Berkeley in Fall 2008 was between a 3.72 and 3.76.**
3. UC Berkeley evaluators now consider your honors work as a factor in the admissions process. **NOTE: Do not forget to mention that you are a member of the Scholars' Honors Program in your application AND personal statement.**

UCLA

Transfer Alliance Program (TAP)

1. Priority admission consideration to the College of Letters and Science. (Impacted majors will likely require higher than a 3.3 GPA and completion of all preparation courses for the major with "A's" and "B's"). "International students are reviewed separately. They can participate in TAP and be certified. Their TAP status is considered when UCLA makes admission decisions, but international students are not considered in the same way as domestic students. Significantly fewer international students are admitted overall than domestic students."
2. TAP applicants are eligible for 40+ TAP Scholarships of \$5000 (renewable for one additional year)
3. 12 units of honors work at Cerritos College will be accepted by the UCLA honors program (requires a 3.5 GPA)
4. TAP/Transfer Conference: an organized visit to the campus to prepare students to transfer
5. Courtesy library card to the main undergraduate library at UCLA
6. Complimentary opportunities to attend academic and cultural events
